TREATMENT:

- A. Treat per Universal Patient Care.
- B. Consider Nitroglycerine 5 mcg/min IV/IO (NTG 0.4 mg SL if IV is not an option)
 - Hypertensive Crises =
 Systolic BP > 220mmHg; Diastolic BP > 130 mmHg and symptoms of end
 organ compromise, I.e. CHF, Pulmonary Edema, unstable angina,
 changes in mental status, CNS changes and renal disease.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS:

The overall goal in pharmacologic therapy is to reduce the patient's blood pressure slowly. Contact Medical Control.
