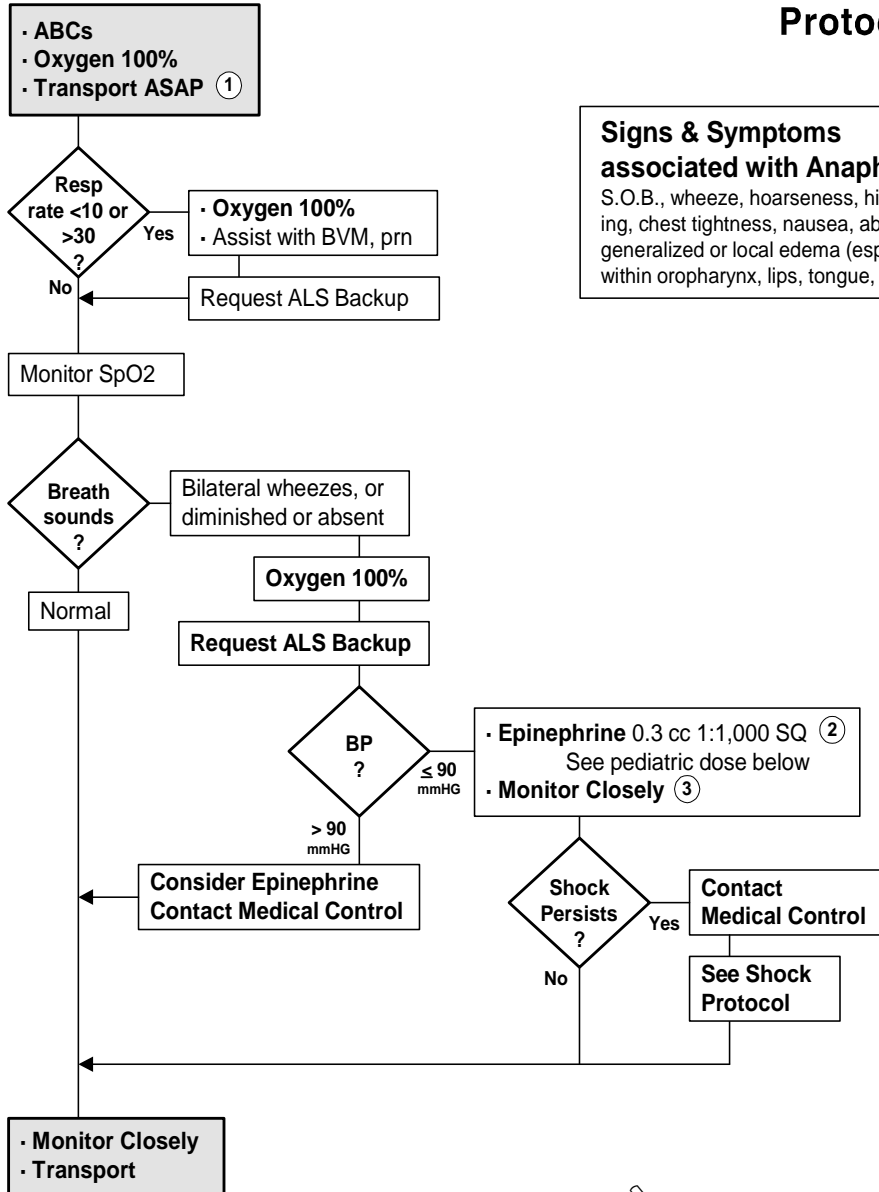


# Anaphylaxis

# BLS Protocol



**Signs & Symptoms associated with Anaphylaxis:**  
 S.O.B., wheeze, hoarseness, hives, itching, flushing, chest tightness, nausea, abdominal cramps, generalized or local edema (especially common within oropharynx, lips, tongue, face).

**Document:**

- Airway
- Respiratory Effort
- Lung Sounds
- Vital Signs, SpO2
- Signs & Symptoms
- Request for ALS Backup
- Skin Color
- Treatment

1 Bee sting: gently remove stinger if still present.  
 2 Epinephrine: pediatric dose = 0.01 mg/kg 1:1,000 SQ.  
 3 Contact Medical Control if symptoms/signs persist.
