

ECEMS Meeting Minutes

Committee Reports

Protocols—Dave met with Dr. Eschelbach today before the meeting. Recently received a call from an ER doctor in Medford. A recent committee reviewed Oregon protocols from Jackson County, Mid Colombia, Multnomah County, and ECEMS. After comparing the different protocols a few changes will be made. A recent call sparked a discussion regarding inconsistencies with ECEMS and Broslow medication dosing. Dave stated that for agencies who use Broslow tapes to rely on Broslow for meds. The trauma system was discussed. The group gave recommendations to Dave to present at the next ATAB 7 meeting. ALO would like prehospital agencies to give a report to the receiving ER when transferring patients.
