


GOOD FIRE OR BAD FIRE?






CAN YOU FIND THE TEN FIRE HAZARDS IN THIS PICTURE?







HOME FIRE ESCAPE PLAN

Tips for creating and practicing your escape plan:

- ☐ Everyone in your household should know two ways to escape from each room in your home.
- ☐ Have an outside Meeting Place (like a tree, light pole or mailbox) a safe distance from the home where everyone should meet.
- ☐ Practice your home fire drill at night and during the day with everyone in your home, twice a year.
- ☐ If the smoke alarm sounds, GET OUT AND STAY OUT. Never go back inside for people or pets.
- ☐ Call the fire department from outside your home.
