Working smoke alarms make you four times more likely to survive a home fire.

All of your smoke alarms work and are installed properly.

There are smoke alarms on every level of your home.

You have smoke alarms inside and outside of all the sleeping areas.

Your smoke alarms are less than 10 years old.

Every month, your smoke alarms are tested.



In a home fire, you may have less than three minutes to escape.

There is a fire escape plan for your home.

Your entire family practices your plan twice a year.

There is a designated family meeting place outside.

Your family keeps exits clear and knows two ways out of every room.
